Rules: Please Read

- Negative Coggins 1 year or less required. Bring copy to leave at office.
- WSCA qualifying classes are in BOLD type.
- WSCA rules apply for WSCA Classes, USEF rules as close as possible for all other classes.
- Walk-Trot 13 & under: RIDER may NOT enter a class requiring a lope.
- Walk-Trot rider/horse combo may NOT enter a class requiring a canter or lope.
- A horse may enter only one WSCA qualifying class per event. This rule does not apply to non-WSCA qualifying classes. (ex: Cannot enter West Ple Non-Stock and age group)
- All classes are for Amateurs with the exception of WSCA and Open classes. Professional Trainers may ride in any class, but are not eligible to be placed.
- Show clothes are optional in non-WSCA qualifying classes.
- Footwear with heels required in all classes.
- Hard hat/helmet required in all hunt classes.
- Schooling equipment allowed in classes designated as *Schooling*. May use schooling equipment in other classes if riding for no ribbons, except NO schooling equipment allowed in WSCA classes.
- @@Trail class will not be held in main arena. Time and judge will be announced but class will start between Noon and 2 pm.
- Novice Rider/ Horse must not have won more than 3 blue ribbons in division.
- MHAHA reserves the right to split, combine and move classes. MHAHA reserves the right to substitute judges and run classes simultaneously.

- 2 High Point Awards for Horse/Rider Combo: 17 and under, 18 and over
- Fees: \$5.00/class Office Fee: \$5.00/horse
- Horse Stalls \$40/stall \$55/tack stall
- Bedding must be purchased at show site
- Friday night stalling
- Camping \$25 payable to fairgrounds
- Jump-out fee \$5/horse if not stalling

NO REFUNDS/ INCOMPLETE OR ILLEGIBLE FORMS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

1. Horses enrolled in the high point program **DO NOT** need to be owned by members of MHAHA at the time points are earned.
2. Rider/Handler/Driver must be an Associate or Affiliate member of MHAHA at the time points are earned – **THIS INCLUDES LEADLINE RIDERS.**
3. Results will be counted per horse/rider combination from a maximum of eight (8) shows submitted per division (ex. 8 shows open division and 8 shows rated division) any shows submitted over the 8 limit **WILL NOT COUNT.**
4. All division totals are based on horse and rider/driver/handler combination. Points accumulate separately for each combination. All entry participants have the option to volunteer a minimum of four (4) hours of MHAHA service between January 1 through November 30, 2018 or PAY A FEE OF \$75.00 per horse/rider combination IN LIEU OF VOLUNTEER HOURS. **LEADLINE ENTRANTS ARE EXCLUDED FROM VOLUNTEER HOURS AND/OR FEE. HIGH POINT ENTRANT IS ENCOURAGED TO WORK THE VOLUNTEER HOURS BUT OWNER, FAMILY MEMBERS OR FRIENDS CAN WORK THE HOURS FOR THE HIGH POINT ENTRANT.** High point entrant can work volunteer hours **INSTEAD OF** the trainer (MHAHA member) if horse is in training and entered in Highpoint with trainer. Volunteer hours could include: pre-show set-up, post show clean-up, office work, gatekeeper, setting up trail, dressage, or jumping classes, manning booths at promotional events, help with newsletter/mailings, etc. The events which qualify as MHAHA events are the MN Horse Expo, MHAHA Spring Schooling Shows, the Great Arabian Get Together, Dog Days Show, Youth fundraising events, MHAHA sponsored clinics and the MHAHA Fall Fun Show. Volunteers are not paid officials or staff. The Volunteer form must be signed by that event's coordinator or assistant.
5. Exhibitors must fully complete and return the entry form(s), report form(s), and volunteer report form(s) and payment to the appropriate address listed on the report form by the deadline listed below.
6. Exhibitors submitting the **OPEN SHOW HIGH POINT REPORTING FORM** must have the placings verified and signed by the Open Show Secretary along with their phone number. If there is no signature and phone number those shows will not be counted.
7. These written rules have precedence over any verbal or implied statement.
8. Fees paid are non refundable
9. Shows that are concurrent or double judged where 2 sets of placings are given count as 2 shows.
10. If you have any questions please contact the High Point Committee for clarification before you submit your points.

1. Each horse/rider combination is a separate entry.
2. Entries must be enrolled on the attached enrollment form and payment included at time of enrollment. \$15.00 per category
3. Leadline is a category with the \$15.00 fee.

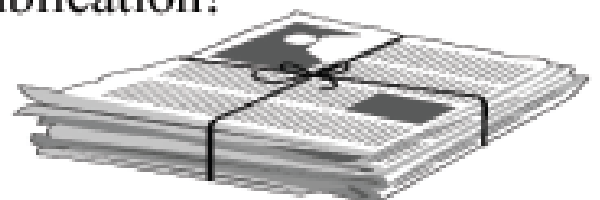
